

ABOUT THE MEMORIAL

The Memorial project was the idea of Tomah area veterans who noted that the community did not have it's own veterans monument. With Tomah's strong military heritage, the logical course was to pursue the construction of a local memorial. The veterans created a key steering committee and the Tomah Area Veterans Memorial Campaign was formed.

Butts Park on Superior Avenue (US Highway 12), just north of downtown Tomah, has been approved by the Tomah City Council as the future site of the Memorial. The site is already home to a WWII vintage U.S. Sherman Tank. This location will maximize the visibility of the



Memorial as it will be located right on the main thoroughfare in town with thousands of cars passing each day.

Memorial construction costs are estimated at approximately \$150,000, including the monument and surrounding landscaping. Funding for this Memorial will come solely from corporate and individual donations, sales of Memorial bricks and memorabilia sold during Memorial events.
